The online structure of BrewingScience – Monatsschrift für Brauwissenschaft subdivides into two areas:

1. Content which is available to all Internet users, and
2. Content which is accessible exclusively for the subscriber.

Comment on 1:

Accessible for all Internet users under the heading “authors” are author guidelines and information on citing frequency (impact factor) as well as paper review details. A list of members of the Scientific Advisory Board is given under “Advisory Panel”.

Furthermore, BrewingScience – Monatsschrift für Brauwissenschaft can be ordered directly online and the media data can also be ordered.

Comment on 2:

www.brewingscience.de has a lot to offer. With his individual access code, the subscriber has access to the contents of the current issue.

The table of contents and a short summary of the contents of the reader service can be read online. The individual articles are available in pdf document format. This file format can be downloaded or opened using “Acrobat Reader” which is available free-of-charge. The articles can then be read either online or off-line (e.g. after having stored the files on disc).

In addition, the subscriber has access to the BrewingScience archive which contains all contributions published in Brewing Science – Monatsschrift für Brauwissenschaft as of 1964 and over 30,000 beverage-related scientific abstracts from all over the world as of 1963 (Reader Service).
